

Application Document Checklist

This application document checklist details the information and supporting documents (personal, health and character) required to assist with the lodgement of a complete application with the department. You may also need to provide additional information and documentation after you have made your application if the department requires it.

After completing this checklist, please attach it to the front of your application.

- Form 1208 – completed in English and signed by the applicant
- A non-refundable Visa Application Charge (VAC)
- A passport that is valid for the total period of your stay in Australia, or for a minimum of 6 months
- One recent passport size photo
- Thai National Identification card and Household Registration
- A letter of support for your application to apply for a Work and Holiday visa.

This letter must be the original letter of approval from the Office of Welfare Promotion Protection and Empowerment of Vulnerable Groups, Ministry of Social Development and Human Security, 618/1 Magason Road, Ratchathewie, Bangkok

Note: the letter of support does not guarantee a place in the Work and Holiday program

- Evidence that you have adequate personal funds, or access to adequate funds to support yourself during the period of intended stay, for example, a current bankbook or bank statement with at least 6 months history of transactions. Cash or credit cards are not sufficient evidence of funds. If you are providing a bankbook, you are required to provide the photocopy and original bankbook which will be returned to you.
- A certified* photocopy of qualification certificate and academic transcript.
- A letter of employment; if applicable
- A certified* photocopy of evidence that you are able to speak English at a functional level.

*Copies of originals can be certified at an AVAC (www.vfsglobal.com/Australia/Thailand).

A certified copy will be included with the application and the original will be returned to you
